# Connie Madigan, 16, Wins Thrilling Carnival Race

The five-mile open skating race at the Oliver Road Recreation Association's Winter Carnival last night will go down on the records as one of the most exciting ever held locally.

The two skaters, with Pickering in the lead most of the way, stuck to each other like glue, and were never separater by more than three or four feet over the 66 laps of the course.

Trailing half a lap behind the leaders was Harold Niemi of the West End Bearcat Club. Alex Cantly of Red Rock, twice winner of the West End Club's five mile race, came in fourth.
