## Madigan Barred Rest of Season All Next Season

Connie Madigan, defenceman with Port Arthur West Ends junior hockey club, has been suspended by the Thunder Bay Amateur Hockey Association for the balance of the current season and all of the 1955-56 season in organized hockey.

The suspension was awarded to Madigan following his demonstration at the Fort William Gardens last Sunday afternoon when he knocked referee Bill McKenzie to the ice after being assessed a minor for charging and a 10-minute misconduct and a game misconduct, both for using profane language.

This is the most severe penalty handed out in the history of the TBAHA and a spokesman said this morning that "the penalty was not severe for the offence committed. Other branches have seen fit to suspend a player for periods of one to five years for offences against referees."

Madigan's chances of making the 'big league' have dwindled badly as the suspension is upheld by all clubs, professional or amateur. At the beginning of the season, Dennis Ball, chief scout for Western Canada for the New York Rangers of the National Hockey League, said the defenceman has the potential ability of becoming a professional and as this was his last year in junior hockey, he would be given a try-out with the pros next Fall.

This is the third suspension for Madigan. He was suspended in 1953 from Oct. 29 to Dec. 1 and again this year for one game against Port Arthur North Stars.
